Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza – 783 E. Butterfield Rd.

The Village has received a request for a Class "A/B-II" liquor license from Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza of Lombard LLC d/b/a Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza located at 783 E. Butterfield Road which would allow alcoholic beverages served as an adjunct to food service with no package sales allowed.

Anthony's Coal Fired Pizza is currently under construction and anticipating a December opening. They will be a full-service restaurant and bar focusing on traditional and specialty made-to-order pizzas as well as other authentic recipes. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That, effective December 1, 2017, Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B-II" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-II" - 10
