SUBJECT: Downtown Improvement & Renovation Grant; 105 W. St. Charles Road, Unit 101, Charred (Exterior Improvements)

The Community Development Department has received an application for the Downtown Improvement and Renovation Grant Program (also known as the Façade Grant Program) for Charred located at 105 W. St. Charles Road. The applicant/business is seeking to install exterior improvements, including accessibility improvements. Charred/Tom Kidwell owns the unit at 105 W. St. Charles Road. The property is located in the Downtown TIF. He has been remodeling the space in preparation for a new restaurant. The space was previously occupied by Capone's and Texas Roadhouse. Neither restaurant received Village TIF grants.

Though this building is under 20 years of age, the ECDC will remember recent text amendments to the Code that striked this provision. The amendments passed on first reading and the Board will make their final vote on May 17<sup>th</sup>. This petition will also need Village Board approval.

The Lombard Downtown Revitalization Project Guidebook focuses on aesthetic standards in Section 4 and keeping with the character of downtown Lombard. The design recommendations can be applied to numerous buildings in downtown Lombard. Though this specific building is not identified in the Guidebook; this project is consistent with the Guidebook and will help in downtown revitalization efforts. Restaurants are a desired use in the downtown and additional businesses will keep the downtown thriving and successful. The Building Division also reviewed the quotes and feels the lowest bid is reasonable in cost for the project.

As noted in an earlier memo, staff is monitoring the Downtown TIF budget. Per the Finance Department, the estimated year end 2018 balance is approximately \$325,000.

#### **GRANT REQUEST ELEMENTS**

Metal Awning/Signage – Based on the lowest bid the applicant is eligible for up to \$13,390.00.

This sign is classified as an Awning Sign in the Zoning Code. At approximately 17 square feet, it meets Village Code for size. It projects approximately four feet onto the public sidewalk. Per Section 153.103 (E), the property owner will be required to provide the Village with insurance and sign an indemnification form. This will be required before the permit will be issued. This is consistent with the projecting signs at Shannon's Deli and Marquette Kitchen & Tap.

The following two items are ADA enhancements to the building exterior. They allow for an ADA ramp and associated items.

Hand Rails – Based on the lowest bid the applicant is eligible for up to \$2,900.00.

The applicant also submitted an invoice from Sara E. F. Gensburg, Ltd. for architectural services in the amount of \$5,500.00 and invoices from Aria Group Architects, Inc. in the amount of \$10,113.09 for design work; per the Façade Grant Program, professional service fees can be included in a grant request. The façade program will fund up to 25% or \$1,500, whichever is less, prior to approval of the architectural renderings. After the architectural renderings are approved, 50% of the fees can be granted. Architectural renderings are approved during the permitting process. The applicant is eligible for \$1,500.00.

The total cost of the project is \$43,530.00 and is grant eligible up to \$21,765.00 plus \$1,500.00 (design fees) for a total of **\$23,265.00** (up to 50% of the eligible project costs; not to exceed \$50,000.00, unless specifically approved by the Village Board).

Staff is supportive of the request for the following reasons:

- 1. Consistent with the recommendations of the Lombard Downtown Revitalization Project Guidebook.
- 2. Consistent with past approval for other façade grant requests.

#### 3. Strong visual enhancement.

#### Conditions of Approval

Staff proposes the following conditions be placed on the grant, if approved by the Village Board of Trustees. The conditions would be incorporated into a Resolution, subject to approval from the Village Board of Trustees.

- 1. Permits must be applied for and received for all of the work. Permits should be applied for with the Building Division and will be ready after the appropriate departments/divisions are able to sign off stating that the project meets code.
- 2. Before the grant can be paid out, the petitioner will submit a final receipt (showing it is paid in full) and waivers of lien from the contractors. This ensures that the project is paid in full before the Village remits the grant funds.
- 3. Work must be complete one year from the date of approval by the Village Board of Trustees.

#### **COMMITTEE ACTION REQUESTED**

This item is being placed on the May 14, 2018 ECDC agenda for consideration. Staff recommends that the ECDC recommend approval to the Village Board for the requested Downtown Improvement and Renovation Grant being sought for the property at 105 W. St. Charles Road. The project total is \$43,530.00 and is grant eligible up to \$23,265.00. As this request is over \$10,000, it requires final approval from the Village Board of Trustees. Said recommendation is subject to the following conditions, by the Village Board of Trustees:

- 1. Permits must be applied for and received for all of the work. All work shall have passed inspections.
- 2. Before the grant can be paid out, Charred will submit a final receipt (showing the project is paid in full) and waivers of lien from the contractors.
- 3. Work must be complete one year from the date of approval by the Village Board of Trustees.




