Sanitary and Storm Sewer CCTV Inspection and Cleaning

Executive Summary/Background

The Village of Lombard received five bids for Sanitary and Storm Sewer CCTV Inspection and Cleaning as part of the Municipal Purchasing Initiative (MPI) for the Governmental Agencies of the Village of Downers Grove, Village of Lombard, and City of Elmhurst. Staff reviewed all bids submitted and deemed Sheridan Plumbing of Bedford Park, IL was the lowest qualified bidder. The Village announced that Sheridan Plumbing was the apparent low bidder at the bid opening and prepared to award the bid to Sheridan Plumbing.

The Village was notified by Sheridan Plumbing on April 24, 2018 that they requested to withdraw their bid due to a calculation error in their submittal. Village staff met with Sheridan to discuss the error and ways that they can fulfill their obligation to the bid. The discussion led to the Village revising the pay items to more accurately represent the scope of work requested.

After meeting with Sheridan, the staff contacted the other governmental agencies included in the bid to seek a consensus of how to proceed. It was decided to reject all bids and seek proposals with the clarified scope from the firms that submitted to the original bid request. It was also decided that each governmental agency would seek proposals for their own quantities independent from each other.

The Village of Lombard notified each bidder that the intent of each governmental agency is to reject the bids and seek proposals.

The following are the bid tabs received from the original bid request with Lombard's quantities identified:

Staff is confident that the revised scope will allow the firms to more accurately submit proposals to maintain the competitive process and provide advantageous pricing to the Village.

Recommendations:

Staff is requesting to reject all bids for RFB: #2018-102 for Sanitary and Storm Sewer CCTV Inspection and Cleaning received on April 20, 2018 and request proposals from the five original bidders with the revised scope of items for the quantities identified for the Village of Lombard.
