Subject: FY 2018-2019 Season Road Salt Purchase

The 2017-2018 winter season has required the Village to use approximately 2400 tons of the road salt supply that it had in reserve. This about 1200 tons more than what we have averaged over the last three years.

The Village participated in DuPage County Department of Transportation's salt bid. Bids for this contract were opened April 25, 2018. Detroit Salt was the lowest bidder with a per ton cost of \$67.15 and will be the provider of bulk road salt for the County's contract. This represents a \$15.66 increase in cost per ton from last year.

Staff would like to exercise the option of purchasing up to 130% of the contract and is requesting the purchase of 2600 tons of salt to replenish the salt that was used during this last winter season and replenish what is estimated to be used this up coming season.

The Village has approximately 5000 tons of salt in reserve in the salt storage dome.

Salt purchase of \$174,590.00 will be paid for by the MFT fund 420.730.730.73310
