RESOLUTION R

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER INVOLVING AN INCREASE/DECREASE IN THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF THE CONTRACT OF \$10,000 OR MORE AND/OR EXTENDING/ SHORTENING THE TIME IN WHICH THE CONTRACT IS TO BE COMPLETED BY THIRTY (30) DAYS OR MORE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 720, Section 5/33E-9, units of local government are required to make specific findings prior to authorizing any change order relative to a contract which would increase or decrease the dollar amount of the contract by \$10,000 or more, or would extend or shorten the time in which the contract is to be completed by thirty (30) days or more; and

WHEREAS, staff has presented and recommended the proposed Change Order No. 2 to the contract between the Village of Lombard and Joseph J. Henderson & Son, Inc. regarding the Central Pressure Adjusting Station Improvements project, as attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made part hereof, (the "Change Order") to the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard; and

WHEREAS, said Change Order attached hereto as Exhibit "A" would increase the dollar amount of the contract by \$25,169.97.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That after reviewing the explanation of staff as to the necessity of and reasons for the Change Order attached hereto as Exhibit "A", the President and Board of Trustees find as follows:

- A That the circumstances which necessitated said Change Order were not reasonably foreseeable at the time the contract was entered into
- B. That the basis of the Change Order was not within the contemplation of the contract when the contract was signed.
- C. That it is in the best interests of the Village of Lombard to approve the Change Order in its proposed form.
- D. That to the extent that it may have been necessary to go to bid relative to the work contemplated by said Change Order; bidding is hereby specifically waived as to the Change Order work.

Change Order #2 (Cabinetry)

Attached, please find Change Order #2 in the amount of \$25,169.97 for additional work in the water testing laboratory of the Central Pressure Adjusting Station. The scope of work is comprised of furnishing and installing metal base cabinets, an epoxy resin sink, epoxy resin countertops and wall cabinets with glass drawers.

During the review of the preliminary project documents, some ideas related to potential cost saving measures were considered. One of the identified areas for potential cost savings was for the Village to purchase and install the cabinetry for the testing laboratory. Since that time, Village staff and the project design consultant (Christopher B. Burke Engineering LTD.) researched cabinet manufacturers and obtained a favorable quote from Carroll Seating to supply and install the cabinets. This information was forwarded to the contractor.

The project award was approximately \$274,000 under the CIP budget, so the furnishing and installation of the cabinetry can be completed well within budget. The work by the contractor will also bring the pressure adjusting station and laboratory facility online much earlier than if Village staff performed the work.

This change order will be presented to the Public Works Committee on December 11, 2018. If the Committee recommends approval, please present this change order to the President and Board of Trustees for their review and approval at their regular meeting on January 3, 2018. If approved, please have a scanned signed copy forwarded to Ray Schwab, Civil Engineer II of the Engineering Division.

The Village of Lombard is requesting a price proposal for additional work to be performed in the laboratory of the Central Pressure Adjusting Station.

Carroll Seating has been selected by the Village of Lombard to furnish and install metal base cabinets, an epoxy resin sink with holes for faucets (to be installed by JJH Plumbing Subcontractor), epoxy resin countertops and wall cabinets with glass drawers.

Please see the attached proposal (CP112493) from Carroll Seating for the above noted work which includes furnishing and installation of the material.

All plumbing fixtures, water supply lines and waste lines shall be furnished and installed by JJH's Plumbing Subcontractor except for the laboratory sink which is integral to the epoxy resin countertop.

The Contractor shall coordinate with Carroll Seating and the Plumbing Subcontractor prior to ordering any plumbing fixtures or laboratory equipment so that faucet holes are properly located and proper plumbing fixtures are ordered.

We assumed the standard 5% markup allowed by the General Terms and Conditions and included this markup in the attached Change Order. Please notify us if there are any additional costs JJH may incur for this work beyond the 5% included in Change Order #2.
