SUBJECT: **ORDINANCE REGARDING VIDEO GAMING AND LIQUOR LICENSES FOR ESTABLISHMENTS WITH VIDEO GAMING - REVISION**

Please be advised that there was a minor technical revision made to the Video Gaming Ordinance on second reading as compared to the version previously reviewed at the first reading on March 21, 2019. The sole revision pertains to amended language to the Class "S-VG" liquor license category.

Consent Agenda Item F on the April 4 Board agenda is an amendment to the Class "S" liquor license category presented in connection with the expansion of Noon Whistle in Lombard. As the Board agenda includes this amendment to the definition of the Class "S" liquor license, the revised video gaming ordinance on second reading was amended to mirror this new language as it pertains to the Class "S-VG" license.

This amendment to the Class "S-VG" liquor license definition is the sole amendment to the Video Gaming Ordinance. All other definitions, sections and restrictions remain unchanged from first reading on March 21, 2019.
