SUBJECT: Surplus Ordinance to Sell Mobile Command Unit

DATE: August 7, 2020

Honorable Lombard Village Board of Trustees,

During this past year, we have identified various areas within our budget to reduce some expenses and expenditures. One such item we have identified is the Mobile Command Unit. By way of introduction, this vehicle was purchased in 2008 with seizure funds. As we have utilized this vehicle over the past 12 years for community events and crimes scenes, we have determined the usefulness of this vehicle does not outweigh the expense and current value of the vehicle. Additionally, in the law enforcement industry, there are other communities that have such equipment that if needed, we can certainly use.

The annual cost of this vehicle for general maintenance is \$4,600 per year. As the vehicle has reached over 10 years old, there are certainly going to be significant maintenance expenses that we will have to incur. Given the aforementioned expenses and the useful need of the vehicle, we have determined there is an opportunity to sell the Mobile Command Unit #141. The sale of this vehicle has been valued between \$75,000 and \$85,000. The fiscal impact of this service change:

- Reduce expenditures by \$4,600 per year along with eliminating the cost of larger repairs.
- If the vehicle is sold at \$80,000, this would be an additional revenue to the seizure accounts.
- The additional revenue received would allow for the police department to replace another out of date vehicle and purchase a newer vehicle, thus eliminating the expense of a new vehicle from the fleet budget.

• The sale would allow for the purchase of current technological equipment that would otherwise be expensed from the department operating funds.

It is with these outlined points, that the sale of this vehicle will reduce expenses within the police department and fleet budgets.

It is my opinion that the Village Board and The Honorable President Giagnorio approve the attached surplus ordinance for the sale of the Mobile Command Unit. If there are any questions, please do not hesitate to reach out to my office.
