Subject: FY21 Vehicle Replacement, One New Fire Engine

The FY 2021 budget includes replacement of a Fire Department fire engine, unit # FR43 a 2005 Pierce Dash fire engine. In addition, the Fire Department has also recommended the disposal of a ladder tower that is no longer operationally needed, unit # FR51 a 2000 Pierce Dash 100 ladder tower (see attached memo from Fire Chief Sander). This will reduce the fire apparatus fleet by one to a total of five vehicles (4 fire engines and 1 ladder tower). Disposal of this ladder tower will reduce maintenance costs and right size the fleet consistent with other towns in the area. Since the lead time to build a fire engine is approximately 10 to 11 months staff would like Village Board authorization to place the order for the vehicle now.

The Fire Department has standardized the fire apparatus fleet with Pierce brand trucks. Pierce is the only manufacture that offers an independent front suspension which improves ride and handling on these heavy trucks. Staff would like to maintain this uniformity and therefore purchase another Pierce fire engine. Pierce brand fire trucks have a proven track record of reliability and dealer support in the area. The Pierce fire engine is serviced by their local dealer MacQueen Emergency of Aurora, (IL).

The Pierce fire engine is available for joint purchase through the Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) contract #F12-19. The fire engine would be purchased direct from Pierce Manufacturing of Appleton, WI and serviced by the dealer in our area, MacQueen Emergency of Aurora, IL. The price of the fire engine is \$650,033. The amount in the 2021 budget for this purchase is \$650,000.

The Village will dispose of the surplus vehicles through a fire apparatus broker, Brindlee Mountain Fire Apparatus of Union Grove, AL for the best price possible. The minimum reserve will be established in the contract/agreement between the Village and the broker and will be the reserve value established in the vehicle reserve sheets, which show Unit 51 at \$45,000 and Unit 43 at \$36,000. Brindlee's commission rates are as follows; sales less than \$125k are 10%, sales from \$125k to 200k are 7% and sales over 200k are 5%.

I recommend the Board of Trustees waive bid and award a contract to Pierce Manufacturing of Appleton, WI in the amount of \$650,033 for one new fire engine equipped per the Village specifications. I also recommend declaring Village unit numbers FR43 and FR51 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing their sale through Brindlee Mountain Fire Apparatus. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the August 20, 2020 meeting.

The Fire Department will purchase a new Fire Engine in FY 2021.

As part of this purchase, the Village will declare the Department's 2000 Pierce Tower Ladder and 2005 Pierce Fire Engine as surplus. This will reduce the Department's fleet of fire apparatus from six to five (four Engines and one Tower Ladder).

After an overall review of the current fire apparatus, the Department's Apparatus Review Committee, recommended to the Fire Chief, the reduction of the Tower Ladder. The Department can still maintain its operational needs with this reduction to the fleet of fire apparatus.
