ORDINANCE NO. 7854

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 150, SECTION 150.103
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO
THE LIFE SAFETY CODE, NFPA 101**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 15, Chapter 150, Section 150.103 of the Lombard Village Code shall be amended to read as follows:

§ 150.103 - Adoption by reference.

(A) The village hereby adopts the **2009 the most current version** of the "The Life Safety Code", NFPA 101 **adopted by the State of Illinois** as published by the National Fire Protection Association for the purpose of regulating and governing the safeguarding of life and property from fires and explosion hazards arising from the storage, handling, and use of hazardous substances, materials, and devices, and from conditions hazardous to life or property in the occupancy of buildings and premises. The terms and conditions of the **2009 State of Illinois's** edition are hereby to be in full force and effect as adopted by the village and subject to any amendments made thereto.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 3: That if any part or portion of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
