Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Election Division has requested that Facility Use Agreements be approved and executed in order to ensure that both polling places remain available on Election Day and that they have the support, cooperation and partnership to take measures to ensure the health and safety of all.

## <u>DUPAGE COUNTY CLERK ELECTION DIVISION</u> FACILITY USE AGREEMENT FOR THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 GENERAL ELECTION

This Facility Use Agreement for a Polling Location for Election Day voting for the November 3, 2020, General Election (the "Facility Use Agreement") is made this 10<sup>th</sup> day of July 2020 by and between the Village of Lombard (the "Village") and the DuPage County Clerk Election Division (the "Election Division"). The Village and the Election Division are hereinafter sometimes individually referred to as a "Party" and collectively referred to as "the Parties").

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Election Division desires to operate a polling place at the Village's Village Hall, Community Room, 255 East Wilson Avenue, Lombard Illinois (the "Polling Location"), at no cost, during the General Election to be held on November 3, 2020, pursuant to the Election Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants herein contained, the Village agrees to allow the Election Division to operate a polling place at the Polling Location at no cost to the taxpayers of DuPage County, and for the convenience of the voters, the Election Division desires to operate said polling place at the Polling Location. For other good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency and receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

1. <u>Term:</u> The term of this Facility Use Agreement shall commence October 31, 2020, at 8:00 a.m. CST and terminate November 5, 2020, at 7:30 pm CST (the "Term"), unless earlier terminated as otherwise provided in this Facility Use Agreement.

## 2. Polling Location and Polling Place:

- A. The Village will provide access to the Polling Location during the Term of this Facility Use Agreement to the Election Division for the purposes of maintaining, and operating a polling place, and use its best efforts to ensure uninterrupted access to said site during the term of this Facility Use Agreement.
- B. The Village will not impede the access to the Polling Location by the Election Division or its employees, contractors, or agents, and the Village shall use its best efforts to cooperate with the Election Division to avoid disruption of the voting process.
- C. The Election Division, at its sole cost and expense, agrees to setup, operate and maintain the polling place at the Polling Location, and to remove all equipment from the Polling Location upon termination or expiration of this Facility Use Agreement.
- 3. <u>Damages, Losses and Theft:</u> The Election Division understands and agrees that the Village is not responsible for:
  - A. any losses or damages of any kind sustained by the Election Division due to theft or damage of any item in the Polling Location;
  - B. any losses of any kind or damages of any kind that arise out of the use and operation of the polling place at the Polling Location by the Election Division; and

C. any injuries, illness, death or property damage caused by the use or operation of the polling place at the Polling Location by the Election Division;

and to the extent any such losses or damages occur, the Election Division agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Village, and its officers, agents and employees, in relation thereto.

- 4. <u>Jurisdiction and Venue:</u> This Facility Use Agreement and all questions of interpretation, construction, and enforcement hereof, and all controversies hereunder, shall be governed by the applicable statutory and common law of the State of Illinois. The Parties agree that the proper venue for any enforcement hereof shall be in the Circuit Court of DuPage County, Illinois.
- 5.
