Awarding Rights-of-way Tree Pruning Contract

On October 7th, 2021, the Village of Lombard advertised for bids for the Village contract PWO 22-15, Rights-of-Way Tree Pruning and Demand Pruning/Cabling. Bid documents were sent to 8 companies. The bid opening was held on October 22th, 2021 with four (4) bids being received. The Bid Tabulation sheet is attached.

D Ryan Tree and Landscape LLC submitted the lowest bid of \$109,654.45 which is \$30,654.45 over what has been budgeted for fiscal year 2022 for rights-of-way tree pruning. The bid documents allow the Village to adjust quantities to fit within budget. The FY22 budget contains \$79,000.00 from the Construction fund RM Program 55 for rights-of-way tree pruning purposes. D Ryan Tree and Landscape Service LLC is the current contract holder and their work has been mostly acceptable.

Staff recommends awarding the contract to D Ryan Tree and Landscape LLC for the amount of \$78,947.90 for parkway tree trimming purposes. Please present this item to the Board of Trustees at the November 4th, 2021 meeting for their approval. This is a one-year contract with two one-year renewal options upon mutual agreement.
