Workshop - Breweries, Distilleries, Wineries etc. Staff solicited a potential interest of the ECDC in a future text amendment to the Village Code relative to breweries, distilleries and wineries. This discussion was a precursor to future engagement with the Plan Commission on modifying the existing code provisions as an economic development tool to attract additional business activity of this type in the Village. The ECDC concurred with staff to take the text amendment to the Plan Commission for future consideration.
