Recommendation from the Economic & Community Development Committee (ECDC) to approve text amendments to Chapter 110 of the Village Code, (Sections 110.21(B), 110.21(C), 110.22(E), 110.25, 110.28(C), 110.28(D) and 110.30) thus altering the fee structure to be an annual fee of \$75 per machine, regardless of the number of machines at a business.
